

Late Arrivals for the School Day

At Britannia Bridge, we understand that sometimes a child can be late arriving at school for a specific reason. We monitor all late arrivals, on a weekly basis.

If your child is persistently late for school, you may receive an Educational Penalty Notice Fine.

School opens the door at 8.50am for a 9.00am registration.

Should your child be late after 9.30am, without evidence of a medical appointment (appointment card or letter), then the child will have an unauthorised absence mark for the morning session.

Being punctual is one of the taught life skills, at Britannia Bridge, we encourage all pupils to learn new skills and gain valuable knowledge, by being in school, on time, at the start of the school day. Arriving late in the morning is very likely to limit the progress your child makes in that particular lesson and could result in your child failing behind and not achieving their full potential.

30 MINUTES A DAY =	20.7 days 89.2% attendance
